


APPLICABLE TO ALL EXAMINATIONS

- · No make-up to be worn for Grades.
- Make-up is acceptable for Stars and Majors.
- The ADA syllabus requires that all shoes be as functionally supportive as possible and from a quality, reputable brand.
- Jewellery is NOT permitted to be worn in any examination with the exception of "Stars" when earrings appropriate to the costume are acceptable.
- Tattoos must be covered and body piercing covered or removed.
- In cold conditions young candidates are permitted to wear a suitable matching "Cross-Over Top".

JAZZ AND TAP DANCE

No dance sneakers to be worn. No ballet shoes for Stars. *Ballet shoes may be worn in Pre-Primary only*. Appropriate and clean footwear must be worn for all examinations.

THE STANDARD ATTIRE for both Grade and Major Examinations is leotard or tight-fitting unitard. Tights may be of any length providing that they are coordinated with the leotard and are complimentary to the line. Flared or neat fitting pants must stop at the ankles so feet may be seen by the Examiner. One Sleeved Leotards are permissible. G-String Leotards are not acceptable.

BOYS are to wear suitably fitted clothes (loose clothing is not permitted).

PRE-PRIMARY AND PRIMARY TAP (GIRLS ONLY) are permitted to wear a suitable dress.

BRONZE STAR AND SILVER STAR Candidates must be uniformly dressed in a stage costume suitable for the style of exam. Make-up and accessories must compliment the outfit.


GOLD STAR AND BAR TO GOLD STAR

Candidates may be individually dressed in a stage costume suitable for the style of exam. Make-up and accessories must complement the outfit. All Stars Candidates must be suitably attired for all examinations in a manner that is not too revealing of their body.

STARS HIP HOP Candidates may wear "appropriate" attire – suitable shoes with a loose singlet style top and Hip Hop style pants may be worn. The students must be able to dress quickly in the exam room and ensure that the feet can be seen.

It is the Candidate's responsibility to ensure all props and costume accessories (as stated in the Stars syllabus) are easy to change into and come into the room at the start of the exam.





CLASSICAL BALLET

PRE-PRIMARY TO GRADE FIVE (GIRLS)

Classical Leotard and Skirt (sheer, above knee in length and full enough for children to hold – Pre-Primary and Primary). Pink ballet shoes (satin, canvas or leather) may have elastic across shoes or ribbons.

Ankle socks (Pre-Primary and Primary) or ballet tights (Grade One to Grade Five) are to be worn. Flowers or ribbons in hair. Props, character shoes and skirts must come into the room with the Candidate.

PRE-PRIMARY TO GRADE FIVE (BOYS)

T-shirt and shorts or tights (black, navy or grey). Socks and ballet shoes with elastic across shoes.

BRONZE STAR TO BAR TO GOLD STAR (FEMALE)

Classical Leotard, Classical Skirts are allowable but not compulsory, (sheer fabric is preferred) ballet tights to be worn. Pink ballet shoes (satin, canvas or leather) may have ribbons or elastic. Flowers or ribbons in hair. Hair style to be of classical style with hair off the face.

BRONZE STAR TO BAR TO GOLD STAR (MALE)

T Shirt and shorts or tights (black, navy or grey). Socks and ballet shoes with elastic across shoes.





CLASS PERFORMANCE AWARDS (CPA)

Please refer to Jazz, Tap and Classical Ballet attire above.



ACRODANCE

GIRLS – A suitable leotard, preferably a high neck. May wear tight fitting shorts. Jazz tights and jazz shoes. Hair in low bun.

BOYS – T-shirt, may wear bike pants with loose fitting shorts over. Socks and jazz shoes.



CONTEMPORARY

GIRLS – A suitable leotard and tights or unitard. Bare foot, socks or foot undies may be worn. Hair in low bun.

BOYS - T-shirt, may wear bike pants with loose fitting shorts over. Bare foot, socks or foot undies may be worn.
